Webinar on Awareness & Prevention of Breast Cancer The Women's Cell of Rosary College of Commerce & Arts, Navelim organised a State Level Webinar on Awareness & Prevention of Breast Cancer for students, academicians and general public via Google Meet. The Resource Person for the session is renowned Oncologist Dr. Shekhar Salkar, Chief of Department of Oncosurgery (Manipal Hospital-Goa).

Dr. Salkar said that with the average age of breast cancer dropping from 50 years to late 30s, breast cancer has become the most widespread cancer not only in urban Indian women but also the in the rural females. Owing to the lack of awareness and absence of a breast cancer screening program, the majority of breast cancers are diagnosed at a relatively advanced stage increasing the risk of mortality. Dr. Salkar emphasized on the important for being aware about breast health care for all women, and regular breast self examination should be part of one's health routine to spot any changes in the breasts. The earlier cancer is detected, the better the chances for treatment and survival.

Our modern lifestyle with no exercise, late marriage or no marriage ,no breast feeding and gorging on fast food make you prone to many health issues including breast cancer. The hormonal imbalance resulting from these irregular lifestyle is the root cause of the growing incidences of breast cancer in India.

Staying aware and paying attention to your own health is important when it comes to breast cancer prevention. He highlighted certain things that women can do for early diagnosis of breast cancer such as Breast Cancer Screenings and Breast Self Examination.

He also recommended some preventive measures such as having first child before the age of 30 ,breast feeding at least for 6 months, limit hormone replacement therapy for short courses. Regular Exercise, Healthy Diet diet with fruits, vegetables, nuts, whole grains and legumes as well fish instead of red meat will reduce the risk of breast cancer. It will also help one maintain their weight and not consume more calories than one should. Women can play a major role, not only in preventing cancer for themselves but also by modifying lifestyle of family members can protect them from not only Cancer, but from many other diseases as
