(SEMESTER I, III, V)**

1) Patriotic Singing

The NSS unit organised a online patriotic singing competition from 13th to 16th August 2020 to commemorate the 74th Independence day. A total number of 4 students participated in the programme. Students had to send a recorded video to participate in the competition., NSS officer Aloysius Godhino was in- charge for the activity . The winner was Arantxa Colaco of SYBA.

2) Poster Competition

The NSS unit organised a online poster designing competition from 13th to 16th August 2020, to commemorate the 74th Independence day. A total number of 9 students , 8 were females and 1 male participated in the programme. NSS officer Ivy Simoes was in-charge for the activity. The winner was Sweta Goankar of TYBA.

3) Peace Day Webinar

To commemorate the International Peace day on 21st September 2020, and to contribute to making the world a more peaceful place” Heartfulness” a non- profit o rganisation” in partnership with the United Nations came together for a global movement to Activate peace. 113 Student attended a programmed streamed via online platforms. 80 were females and 33 were males. NSS Programme officer MS. Anneliese was incharge for the programme.

4) Child Sexual Abuse and POCSO Act 2012

Sakshi (NGO) in collaboration with NSS unit of the college organised a webinar on topic “Raising Awareness about Child Sexual Abuse and POCSO Act” as a part of Rakshin Project on 24th September 2020. A total of 88 NSS volunteers were a part of this programme out of which 28 were males and 60 were females. 21) National Youth Week

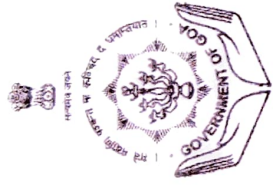
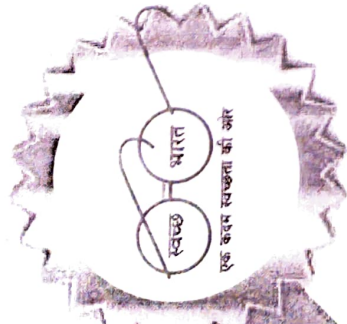
