A. GU-ART Coverage:

1. Admission to the Post Graduate Programmes shall be based on GU-ART. For details of Programmes offered at the University Schools and Affiliated Colleges, Seat Matrix and Reservations refer [Annexure I](#) & [Annexure II](#) respectively.
2. Admissions to the B.Ed Programme for the academic year 2023-24 offered at the Affiliated Colleges shall also be based on the GU-ART along with the other eligibility criteria as prescribed in [Annexure III](#) by the Directorate of Higher Education (DHE), Government of Goa.

B. Eligibility:

Admissions to the Post Graduate Programmes shall be entirely based on the **Goa University - Admissions Ranking Test (GU-ART)**. The marks/percentage obtained by the candidate while graduating would only be used to ascertain the eligibility of candidates for the Programme. The purpose of the GU-ART is only to rank the prospective candidates and not for determination of pass/ fail.

Candidates who are in their Final Year of Graduation are also eligible to apply.

Selected candidates who are in the Final Year of Graduation shall be granted Provisional Admission. Their admission shall be confirmed after the results are declared based on the eligibility. In case a candidate fails to clear the Graduation Examination, the admission shall stand cancelled and the fees shall be refunded.

C. Filling up of the Online Application Form:

- a) The **LAST DATE** for submission of applications is **25th January 2023**.
- b) Candidates are advised in their own interest to apply online much before the closing date and not wait till the last date for applying/payment of application fee to avoid the possibility of disconnection/inability/ failure to log on to the website on account of heavy load on the website.
- c) Goa University does not assume any responsibility to candidates in case they are unable to submit their application by the last date on account of the aforesaid reasons or for any other reason beyond the control of the University.
- d) Printout of the application form is **NOT REQUIRED to be submitted to the University**.

Application Fees (Non-refundable) (To be paid online through GUMS portal only):

- INR 600 in case Un-reserved/ EWS/OBC (Non Creamy Layer) per subject/specialization.
- INR 300 in case of SC/ST of Goa. * per subject/specialization.
- No fees shall be charged from Persons with Disability.

*Candidates applying for admission under these categories shall be required to submit a valid certificate to that effect issued by the Officer of the rank of the Deputy Collector or any other authorized Officer as notified by the Government of Goa.

D. GU-ART: Candidates are requested to note the following details regarding the GU-ART.

- 1. Candidates shall be permitted to apply for a maximum of three subjects/specializations for the PG Programmes and a maximum of two subjects/specializations for the B.Ed. Programme.**
2. Candidates who wish to apply for more than one programme are required to use the same login details. No changes shall be entertained after the application is submitted online.
3. The GU-ART shall be of One Paper of 100 marks, containing 50 objective Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQ) of 2 marks each. There shall be negative marking, where half a mark shall be deducted for each wrong answer. No marks shall be deducted for unanswered questions. The duration of the GU-ART shall be 90 minutes.
4. The breakup of 100 marks for the GU-ART Question Paper shall be as follows:

- a. Section I (Least difficult) - 15 Questions
 - b. Section II (Difficult) - 15 Questions
 - c. Section III (Most difficult) - 20 Questions
5. In case candidates who have answered the GU-ART and have secured equal marks in the ranking list:
- a. Section III scores shall be the first level of tie breaker, followed by Section II
 - b. In case the tie still exists, the University shall decide the order of merit.

7. A Common GU-ART shall be conducted for admission to
- M.Sc. Environmental Science and MA Environmental Science.
 - M.Com & Post Graduate Diploma in Finance and Taxation.
8. Additional GU-ART Rounds shall be conducted only if seats remain vacant in the respective subject/ specialization Programmes. However, candidates answering the subsequent GU-ART Rounds shall be ranked after the previous Round candidates.

Example: If 100 candidates apply for Round I, all 100 shall be assigned a rank based on the marks scored. For Round II, candidates shall be ranked from 101 onwards. The candidate scoring highest marks at GU-ART Round II shall be ranked 101.

GU-ART Schedule:

THE GU-ART SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN OFFLINE MODE ONLY.

The Schedule for the GU-ART Round I shall be as follows:

The First Round of GU-ART shall be held at the **Goa University Campus, Taleigao Plateau** as per the dates given below:

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Admission Process:

1. The results of **GU-ART Round I** shall be displayed on the University Website tentatively by **22nd March 2023**.
 - a. For **Programmes offered only at the University Schools or at a single College**, the seats shall be allotted to candidates based on their performance in the GU-ART. Rules/Guidelines for allotment of seats are given in [Annexure VI](#).
 - b. For **Programmes offered at both the University as well as the affiliated colleges or at multiple colleges**, seats shall be allotted through **PHYSICAL COUNSELLING** which shall be held at the Goa University Campus ([click here to refer List of Programmes](#)). The rankers shall confirm their course selection (In case candidates have applied for GU-ART in multiple subjects/ specialization) and selection of seat at University School or at affiliated college. The candidates are required to indicate a maximum of three preferences for institution of admission and subject specialization if applicable.
2. All Candidates including those who are Selected/Allotted/Offered seats at the Goa University Schools or Affiliated Colleges shall be required to pay the Seat Confirmation Fee of Rs.5,000/- online on the GUMS Portal.

3. Reserved Category Seats remaining vacant after the 1st Provisional List of the First Round of GU-ART shall be transferred to the Un-reserved Category.
4. Additional GU-ART Rounds shall be conducted only if seats remain vacant in the respective subject/ specialization Programmes. However, candidates answering the subsequent GU-ART Rounds shall be ranked after the previous Round candidates.
5. **PHYSICAL COUNSELLING** will be held on **30th March 2023** and **31st March 2023**

RESERVATION GUIDELINES

Reservation of seats for admission to the various Programmes of study shall be on the basis of the Reservation Policy of the Goa State Government.

Candidates applying for admission under the Reserved Categories shall be required to submit a valid Certificate to that effect issued by the Officer of the rank of the Deputy Collector or any other authorized Officer as notified by the Government of Goa.

1. **2%** of seats in each of the Post Graduate programmes of study, subject to a **minimum of one seat**, shall be reserved for candidates belonging to **SC Category of Goa State**.
2. **12%** of seats in each of the Post Graduate programmes of study, subject to a **minimum of one seat**, shall be reserved for candidates belonging to **ST Category of Goa State**.
3. **27%** of total seats, subject to a **minimum of two seats**, for admission to various programmes of study, shall be reserved for candidates belonging to the Other Backward Classes Non-Creamy Layer (**OBC-NCL**) of the State of Goa as per the directives of the State Government.
4. **5%** of total seats, subject to minimum one seat for admission to the various programmes of study shall be reserved for **Person with Disability (PwD)** candidates as per State Government directives.
5. **10%** of seats, subject to a **maximum of two seats and a minimum of one seat** in each programme of study, shall be made available for candidates of **other Indian Universities**.
6. **10%** of total seats shall be reserved for **Economically Weaker Section of Un-Reserved Category (EWS)** as per the directives of the State Government.
7. **1%** of total seats shall be reserved for **Children of Ex- servicemen**.
8. **15%** of seats, over and above the allotted number of seats, shall be reserved as supernumerary seats for the overseas candidates, who are eligible for admission and are recommended by the Govt. of India under Scholarship from Govt. of India or under exchange programme (ICCR Programme). These seats shall be filled in accordance with the UGC Guidelines. Out of the 15% supernumerary seats, one seat in each program will be reserved for Kashmiri Migrants (KM) as per directives of the UGC.

Percentage of seats mentioned above is subject to change depending upon the Directives of the Goa State Government.

REFUND OF COURSE FEES

- a) If a student chooses to withdraw from the programme of study in which s/he is enrolled, the following five tier system shall be followed for the refund of fees remitted by her/him.

Sr. No.	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is served to the Institution	% of refund of Aggregate fees*
1.	15 days or more before the formally notified last date of admission. #	100%
2.	Less than 15 days before the formally notified last date of admission.	90%
3.	15 days or less after the formally notified last date of admission.	80%
4.	30 days or less, but more than 15 days after the formally notified last date of admission.	50%
5.	More than 30 days after the formally notified last date of admission.	0%

* Inclusive of tuition fees and non-tuition fees but exclusive of Caution Deposit

Last date of admission shall be notified later on the university website.

- b) In case of (1) in the table above, 5% of the aggregate fees paid by the student, subject to a maximum of Rs. 5,000/- shall be deducted as processing charges from the refundable amount.
- c) Fees shall be normally refunded to an eligible student within fifteen days from the date of receiving the application.
- d) All other cases of refund of fees will be decided on a case to case basis on its merit.
- e) **The Seat Confirmation Fee is fully refundable in case of withdrawal of provisional admission within 60 days from the last date of admission.**

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ANNEXURE V
ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO PG PROGRAMMES

A] Shenoi Goembab School of Languages & Literature:

Master of Arts English, French, Hindi, Konkani, Marathi and Portuguese:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Arts, a candidate shall have passed the examination of Degree of Bachelor of Arts General/ Honors of the University in the subject for which admission is sought or an examination of any other University recognised as equivalent thereto.

B] DD Kosambi School of Social Sciences & Behavioural Studies:

i) Master of Arts in History, Political Science, Sociology, Geography and Psychology:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Arts a candidate shall have passed the examination of Degree of Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) General/ Honors in the subject for which admission is sought of the University or any other University recognised as equivalent thereto.

ii) Master of Library and Information Science (M.L.I.Sc):

Graduates in any discipline of the University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto shall be eligible to apply for admission. A student exiting the M.L.I.Sc. Programme after successfully completing one year (40 Credits) shall be awarded B.L.I.Sc. Degree. A student who have completed the B.L.I.Sc. shall be offered admission for Semester III of M.L.I.Sc. programme.

C] Goa of Business School:

i) Master of Arts in Economics :

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Arts in Economics, a candidate must have passed the examination of Degree of Bachelor of Arts General/ Honors of the University in the subject for which admission is sought or an examination of any other University recognised as equivalent thereto.

ii) Masters of Commerce (M.Com):

To be eligible for admission to the programme leading to the Degree of Master of Commerce (M.Com.), a candidate must have passed the examination for the Degree of B.Com/BBA/BBA(FS), of this University or an examination of any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

iii) Master of Travel and Tourism Management:

To be eligible for admission to the programme leading to the Degree of Master of Travel and Tourism Management, a candidate must have completed graduation in any discipline from this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

D] School of Physical and Applied Sciences:

i) Master of Science in Mathematics and Physics:

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Mathematics and Physics, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors in the subject for which admission is sought of the University or any other University recognised as equivalent thereto.

ii) Master of Science in Electronics:

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Electronics, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science with Physics/ Computer Science/ Electronics of the University or from any other recognised University.

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E] School of Biological Sciences & Biotechnology:

i) Master of Science in Microbiology, Botany and Zoology:

To be eligible for admission to Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Microbiology/Botany/Zoology, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors in the subject for which admission is sought of the University or any other University recognised as equivalent thereto.

ii) Master of Science in Biotechnology:

Candidates having Bachelor's Degree in Natural / Biological & Clinical Sciences, Agricultural / Veterinary / Fishery Sciences / Pharmacy / Engineering / Technology or 4-years B.Sc. (Physician Assistant) or Medicine (MBBS) or B.D.S., with at least 55% marks, shall be eligible for the Programmes. Admissions to Marine Biotechnology Admissions are granted on the basis of the National Combined Entrance Examination in Biotechnology conducted by Jawaharlal Nehru University (New Delhi) at various centres.

iii) Master of Science in Food Technology:

A Candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors in Food Science / Food Technology / Microbiology / Biotechnology / Biochemistry / Life Sciences/ Biological Sciences / Home Science / Food, Nutrition and Dietetics and Allied Sciences OR four years Bachelor's Degree in Agriculture/ Veterinary/ Forestry/ Pharmacy/ Fishery Sciences / B.E. (Biochemical / Biotechnology)/ B.Tech (Biochemical / Biotechnology/ Food Science / Food Technology).

(iv) Post Graduate Diploma in Medical Laboratory Techniques (PGDMLT)

A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Diploma in Medical Laboratory Techniques must have passed the examination of degree of Bachelor of Science of this University or from any other recognized University, with at least 32 credits in the first, second and third years taken together under the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) in the subject of either Microbiology, Bio-technology, or Zoology, and must have offered Chemistry as a subject upto the second year level. In Semester system of examination, the number of papers or units shall be 14, with a total of 1400 marks, out of which eight papers are studied in F.Y. and S.Y. taken together and minimum 6 papers in T.Y. for being eligible for PG admission in that subject.

F] School of Chemical Sciences:

i) Master of Science in Chemistry:

- a) To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Chemistry, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science of the University General/ Honors or from any other recognized University, in the subject for which admission is sought.
- b) Candidates applying for admission to the M.Sc. Programme in Chemistry shall be eligible to be admitted to only one of the various specializations at M. Sc., Part II, as notified in the University Prospectus.
- c) Allotment of seats under various specializations of the Master's Programme in Chemistry, shall be specified in the University Prospectus.

ii) Master of Science in Biochemistry:

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Biochemistry, a candidate shall have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors of this University or from any other recognized University. in Chemistry / Biological Sciences (Botany, Zoology/ Microbiology/ Biochemistry/ Biotechnology and allied subjects.

G] School of Earth, Ocean and Atmospheric Sciences:

(i) Master of Science in Applied Geology:

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Applied Geology, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors of the University or from any other recognized University, in the subject for which admission is sought.

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(ii) Master of Science in Marine Science:

- a) To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Marine Science Programme, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science of the University or from any other recognized University, in Mathematics/Physics/Chemistry/Biology/Hydrochemistry/ Environmental Science/ Environmental Chemistry/ Marine Science/Ocean Science/Biotechnology. A candidate with BSc Geography /B.C.A with mathematics at HSSC level is also eligible.

(iii) Master of Science in Marine Microbiology:

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Marine Microbiology, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors in Microbiology/ Biotechnology of the University or from any other recognized University.

(iv) Master of Science in Environmental Science/ Master of Arts in Environmental Studies:

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Environmental Science, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors of the University or from any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Arts in Environmental Science must have passed the examination of Degree of Bachelor of Arts General/ Honors of the University or an examination of any other University recognized.

H] School of International and Area Studies:

(i) MA International Studies:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Arts in International Studies, a candidate must have completed graduation in any discipline from this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

I] Manohar Parrikar School of Law, Governance & Public Policy:

(i) Master of Social Work:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Social Studies a candidate must have completed graduation in any discipline from this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

(ii) Master of Arts in Women's Studies:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Arts in Women's Studies, a candidate must have completed graduation in any discipline from this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

(iii) Master of Arts in Public Administration:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Arts in Public Administration, a candidate must have completed graduation in any discipline from this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

(iv) Master of Laws:

To be eligible for admission to Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Laws, a candidate must have completed graduation in Law from this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

J] School of Sanskrit, Philosophy and Indic Studies:

(i) Master of Arts in Philosophy:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Arts in Philosophy, a candidate must have passed the examination of Degree of Bachelor of Arts General/ Honors in the subject of Philosophy from this University or any other University recognised as equivalent thereto.

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CHANGE OF DISCIPLINE

1. **Change of Subject for Candidates for Master of Arts / Master of Commerce Programmes:** Candidates who have passed Bachelor's Degree examination in any subject of this University or any other recognized University and secured at least 40% of the aggregate marks in their qualifying examination may seek admission to the **Master of Arts Degree Programme/ Master of Commerce Programme** in a subject of their choice.
2. **Change of Subject for Candidates for Master of Science Programmes:** Candidates who have passed Bachelor's Degree examination in any Science subject of this University or any other recognized University and secured at least 40% of the aggregate marks in their qualifying examination may seek admission to the Master of Science Degree Programme subject to the following:
 - i. Candidates who intend to apply for the M.Sc. Programmes in the discipline in which they have not studied at the undergraduate level are required to answer the Change of Discipline Test (CDT) in addition to the Ranking Test in the respective subject.
 - ii. The CDT shall be on the lines of the Ranking Test. Candidates are required to score a minimum of 50% marks in the CDT to pass the test.
 - iii. The CDT shall be conducted prior to the Ranking Test, by the respective School. In case the programme is not offered at the University School, then the Test shall be conducted at the college offering the programme designated by the University.
 - iv. Only qualified candidates will be eligible to answer the Ranking Test in the respective subject.
 - v. The CDT will be conducted only once in a year before the first Round of Ranking Test, tentatively by **10th February 2023** in offline mode.
 - vi. The Eligibility for the CDT shall be as per OA-20.

Change of Discipline Test:

The Change of Discipline Test shall be of 50 MCQ each carrying 2 marks for the correct answer and 0.5 negative (-ve) marks for a wrong answer. No marks will be deducted for unanswered questions. The duration of the Test shall be of 90 minutes. Candidates are required to score a minimum of 50% marks in the Change of Discipline Test to pass the test.

How to apply:

Candidates are required to select the "Change of Discipline" option while filling the online application form.

Under the scheme of Change of Discipline, the candidates who have answered the Ranking Test shall be considered eligible for admission against the vacant seats available, if any, after students from the merit lists of concerned programme are given admission.

Under the scheme of Change of Discipline, up to two seats may be made available as supernumerary with the approval of Vice-Chancellor, if no vacant seats are available for the qualified candidates and if the normal supernumerary seats are not filled.

B. Selection of Candidates for Programmes which are offered at multiple locations/Institutions.

For Programmes offered at both the University as well as the affiliated colleges or at multiple colleges, seats shall be allotted through **PHYSICAL COUNSELLING** which shall be held at the Goa University Campus

ANNEXURE VII

In order to curb the bad practices such as ragging on the University campus and in its affiliated colleges, the University authorities are committed to strictly take serious actions on the matter as supported by the law and follow UGC Regulation on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 (<http://www.ugc.ac.in/page/ragging-related-circulars.aspx>) as well as Goa Prohibition of Ragging Act, 2008 and the amendments carried out thereafter.

All concerned must know what constitutes 'ragging'. Any or in multiples of the following acts constitutes ragging:

- Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students
- Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher.

Following functionaries are in place with defined responsibilities:

ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE

- Ensure the compliance of provisions pertaining to UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging as well as the provision of the Goa Prohibition of Ragging Act 2008 (and amendments)
- Monitor, oversee and guide the anti-ragging squad

ANTI RAGGING SQUAD

- Make surprise raids on hostels, other hot-spots to inspect places of potential ragging on the campus
- Conduct an on-the-spot enquiry* into any incident of ragging referred by any person and submit an enquiry report along with recommendations to the Anti-Ragging Committee for action under clause (a) 9.1 of UGC Regulations on curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 and other relevant Rules/State Acts in force.

MONITORING CELL

Co-ordinate with the affiliated Colleges and institutions to curb the menace of ragging

- Invite reports from the heads of the educational institutions in regard to the activities of the functionaries at their end,
- Conduct orientation programmes, counselling sessions, the incidents of ragging, the problems faced by the wardens or other officials.
- Keep abreast of the decisions of the District level Anti Ragging Committee.
- Review the efforts made by the institutions to publicize anti-ragging measures, soliciting undertakings from parents and students for each academic year to abstain from ragging activities or willingness to be penalized for violations
- Function as the prime mover for initiating action on the part of the appropriate authorities of the Goa University for amending its Statutes or Ordinances or Bye-laws as the case may be and to facilitate the implementation of Anti-Ragging measures at the level of the institutions
- Send the status reports periodically to the state level monitoring cell at the frequencies laid down with the support on logistics and smooth functioning from the [Directorate of Students Welfare](#).

As a part of UGC's initiative towards reduction compliance burden of its stakeholders, UGC has revised the procedure for students to file online Anti Ragging Affidavit. The revised procedure is as follows:

Step 1: A student will submit his/her details on the same website (www.antiragging.in and www.amanmovement.org) as before; read and confirm that he/she and his/her parents/Guardians have read and understood the AICTE regulations on curbing the menace of ragging. He/She will confirm & agree that he/she will not engage in ragging in any form. (Step is the same like before)

Step 2: The students will receive an e-mail with his/her registration number and a web link. The student will forward the link to the e-mail of the Nodal in his/her University/College. (Please note the student will not receive pdf affidavits and he/she is not required to print & sign it as used to be case earlier)

Step 3: The Nodal Officer in the University/College can click on the link of any forwarded e-mails that he/she will receive from any student of his/her college to get the list of those students who have submitted Anti Ragging Affidavits/Undertaking in his/her college. The list will be updated every 24 hours.

It may be noted that it is compulsory for each student and his/her parent/Guardian to submit an online undertaking each academic year of the two designated websites, namely, www.antiragging.in and www.amanmovement.org.
