CIRCULAR

Principals of the Colleges affiliated to the Goa University offering BBA and MBA Programmes are hereby informed the University has approved the following Guidelines to be followed for Admission:

A. Entrance Test:

- 1. BBA: The admissions to the BBA Programme shall be carried out based on an entrance Test, the test may be conducted internally by the respective College or UGAT.
- 2. MBA: The valid score of CMAT conducted by NTA and/or ATMA conducted by AIMS, shall be considered for admission to the 2024-26 batches of all MBA programmes on campus and in affiliated colleges.

B. Weightage:

- 1. BBA: There shall be 50% weightage for entrance test scores, 30% weightage for Personal Interview and 20% weightage for the scores in 12th standard or equivalent acceptable Programme while admitting students to BBA.
- 2. MBA: A cut-off percentile, if any, of a test score, shall be decided at the time of admission. There shall be 60% weightage for test scores, 15% weightage for group discussion, 15% weightage for a personal interview and 10% weightage for work experience (2% weightage for every year (1/60 points for every completed month) of work experience subject to a maximum of 5 years).

C. Tie-Breaker:

- 1. BBA: The Personal Interview as the first, test scores as the second and 12th standard, or equivalent acceptable Programme score as the third tiebreaker shall be followed, in case of equal total scores for two or more candidates. In case the score remains the same after the use of tiebreakers, candidates with the same score shall be admitted to the Programme, taking special approval from the higher authority.
- 2. MBA: The test score shall be followed as the first, the Personal Interview score as the second, the group discussion score as the third and the work experience score as the fourth tiebreaker in case of equal total scores for two or more candidates. In case the score remains the same after the use of tiebreakers, candidates with the same score shall be admitted to the Programme, taking special approval from the higher authority.

D. Other:

- 1. The percentage of seats reserved for Reserved Categories shall be as specified by the University based on State Government directives.
- 2. Supernumerary seats shall be used only for foreign nationals and shall be as per the limits prescribed by the University.
- 3. Procedure for the admission of waitlisted Candidates: A merit list shall be prepared based on the weights at Point B above. If there are applications for more than the seats allotted to the colleges/institutions, they shall be kept on the waitlist. They shall be admitted in order of merit if there are any cancellations of the admissions. Rules w.r.t. reservations shall be followed wherever applicable.
